CFIA Compliance Workshop Agenda Announced

Washington, D.C./Toronto, Ontario, November 2, 2007 - NAMP and the Further Poultry Processing Association of Canada, jointly hosting the last Compliance Verification Seminar before the Canadian Food Inspection Agency begins the implementation phase, have announced the completion of the event's agenda. The workshop, free to NAMP and FPPAC members, is scheduled for November 16 at the Park Plaza Toronto airport.

CFIA representatives led by Dave Gagnon, Tom Graham and Dave Engel will talk about industry responsibilities, the CVS task structure and enforcement strategies. The day long event will also feature a session on developing acceptable action plans.
